

TO ENTER: Sign-up at the Hitch'N Post Western Store. There is no charge to enter. Contestants will receive a participation bandana and can pick up a Dacotah Stampede Wild Stick Horse (taming the stick horse is the responsibility of the contestant) at the Hitch'N Post. Contestants have the option of using their own stick horses.
RULES: The contestants may compete in up to three events.

Stick Horse Parade: Contestants will parade their Stick Horse around the ring after participating in each event. Cowboy and Cowgirl attire is highly recommended. Prizes for winners in each event will be presented by Hitch'N Post.

NO PETS ALLOWED IN CORE AREA

The Brown County Fair Board has enacted a **NO PETS** policy in the core area of the fairgrounds. Pets are not allowed in the buildings, barns, or in the areas where commercial vendors such as concessionaires, machinery or the carnival are set up. Pets are also not allowed in the grandstand.

Pets **are** allowed in the campgrounds and parking lots, but are not allowed beyond those areas. Please keep that in mind before you bring your pets to the fair.

The Brown County Fairgrounds has an ordinance in effect that requires pet owners to clean up after their pets while on the Fairgrounds.

ANY PETS LEFT IN VEHICLES WILL BE REPORTED TO BROWN COUNTY DISPATCH!

Exceptions: Service animals and animals that are on the grounds for exhibition in a 4-H and Open Class Livestock event.
