





REGISTRATION: 2:30 p.m. TIME: 3:00 p.m. AGE LIMIT: Ages 3-8

LOCATION: Trusty's Tent by Climate Control

TO ENTER: Sign-up at the Hitch'N Post Western Store. There is no charge to enter. Contestants can pick up a Dacotah Stampede Wild Stick Horse (taming the stick horse is the responsibility of the contestant) at the Hitch'N Post. Contestants have the option of using their own stick horses.

RULES: The contestants may compete in up to three events.

Stick Horse Parade: Contestants will parade their Stick Horse around the ring after participating in each event. Cowboy and Cowgirl attire is highly recommended. Prizes for winners in each event will be presented by Hitch'N Post. Contestant turn in their number when done and receive a participation

- bandana. Pole Bending: Contestants will ride their Stick Horse in and out of a line of poles, circling the last pole and weaving in and out of the poles back to the start/finish line.
- Barrel Race: Contestants will ride a traditional clover leaf barrel pattern around three barrels.
- Best Dressed Contest: Contestants will compete for best dressed horsemanship outfit (horse & rider).

Every contestant receives a bandana for participating!

Parents and grandparents earn bragging rights. Flash photos are allowed. Judges decisions are final.



FAIR POLICIES

NO PETS ALLOWED IN CORE AREA

The Brown County Fair Board has enacted a **NO PETS** policy in the core area of the fairgrounds. Pets are **not** allowed in the buildings, barns, or in the areas where commercial vendors such as concessionaires, machinery or the carnival are set up. Likewise, pets are **not** allowed in the grandstand.

Pets are allowed in the campgrounds and parking lots, but are not allowed beyond those areas. Please keep that in mind before you bring your pets to the fair.

Brown County Fairgrounds ordinance mandates pet owners clean up after their pets while on the Fairgrounds.

ANY PETS LEFT IN VEHICLES WILL BE REPORTED TO **BROWN COUNTY DISPATCH!**

Exceptions: Service & performance animals and animals that are on the grounds for exhibition in a 4-H and Open Class Livestock event.



GOLF CART, ATV & UTV POLICY



Golf Cart, ATV & UTV operators must have a valid driver's license. Carts are NOT allowed in the CORE AREA. They must have a headlight when operated in the dark.
